| □ Pack books, DVDs, games, and décor items first.   |

| $\hfill\square$ Wrap framed photos, mirrors, and artwork with bubble wrap or cardboard corners. |
| □ Use blankets or furniture pads for sofas, tables, and chairs.                                 |
| □ Label cords and remotes in zip-lock bags (tape them to the TV or device).                     |
| □ Roll up rugs and secure with tape.  |
| □ Dust and clean furniture before moving so it's ready in your new home.                        |

### **KITCHEN**

| □ start with rarely used appliances and specialty dishes.                        |

| □ Wrap plates vertically (like records) with packing paper for strength.         |
| □ Use pots and pans to hold smaller kitchen items.                               |
| □ Tape silverware trays or wrap knives carefully.                                |
| □ Place spices and pantry items in small, sealed containers.                     |
| □ Toss expired or nearly empty condiments.                                       |

#### **BEDROOMS**

□ Dack off-spacen clothing first

☐ Toss expired medications and products.

| □ Use wardrobe boxes for hanging clothes.                               |
| □ Pack shoes in original boxes or wrap in paper to avoid scuffing.      |
| □ Keep bedding sets together in clear, labelled bags.                   |
| □ Empty nightstands and dressers into boxes — move furniture lighter.   |
| □ Pack jewellery, passports, and valuables separately to move yourself. |

### **BATHROOMS**

| □ Pack towels and shower curtains together.                                    |

| □ Put liquids and toiletries in sealed plastic bags to prevent leaks.          |
| □ Keep one toiletries bag handy for moving day (toothbrush, soap, shampoo, TP) |
| □ Remove any hardware like towel racks or shelves if taking them.              |



## ROOM-BY-ROOM CONTINUED...

### **KIDS' ROOMS & PLAYROOMS**

- □ Involve kids by letting them choose a "first-night box" with their favourite toys.
- ☐ Use lidded bins for toys and games—easy for quick cleanups.
- □ Pack books, extra stuffed animals, and wall décor early.
- □ Disassemble large play items (play kitchens, dollhouses) and bag small parts.

### **GARAGE, BASEMENT & STORAGE**

- □ Safely pack tools in sturdy boxes (bundle cords, secure blades).
- ☐ Drain fuel from lawnmowers, snowblowers, or trimmers.
- □ Dispose of paints, chemicals, propane tanks, or cleaners safely.
- □ Group seasonal décor and sports gear together.
- □ Coil hoses and extension cords neatly.

### **OFFICE**

- □ Pack important documents in a lockable or fireproof box.
- □ Back up files before moving computers.
- □ Label cables and take photos before disconnecting electronics.
- $\hfill\square$  Wrap electronics in bubble wrap or blankets.

## **EXTERIOR (PORCH, SHED, YARD)**

- ☐ Pack patio cushions and outdoor furniture.
- □ Bundle garden tools together with twine.
- □ Drain and coil hoses neatly.
- □ Empty planters or garden décor (they can be heavy when full).
- □ Clean and pack BBQ (remove propane tanks can't move them).
- □ Organise shed contents (power tools, lawn supplies).
- ☐ Remove seasonal items (sleds, sprinklers, outdoor toys).

#### **PRO TIPS**

- ✓ Label every box with the room + contents. Use colour-coded tape for each room.
- ✓ Create an "Open First Box" for each main room (kitchen, bedrooms, bathrooms).
- ✓ Declutter before packing less to move, less to unpack.
- ✓ Keep essentials (medications, chargers, documents) with you, not in the moving truck.
